- February 2nd, 2017: start of application process (Phase 1)
- March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2017: end of application process (Phase 1)
- April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017: start of registration process (Phase 2)
- May 12<sup>th</sup>, 2017: end of registration process (Phase 2)
- May 28<sup>th</sup> – June 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2017: 22<sup>nd</sup> ICNEM at the Institut d'Études Scientifiques de Cargèse (IESC) in Corsica.

## Registration Procedure

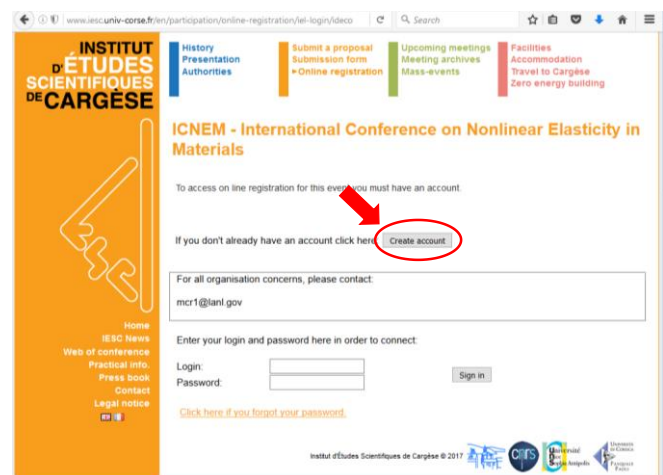
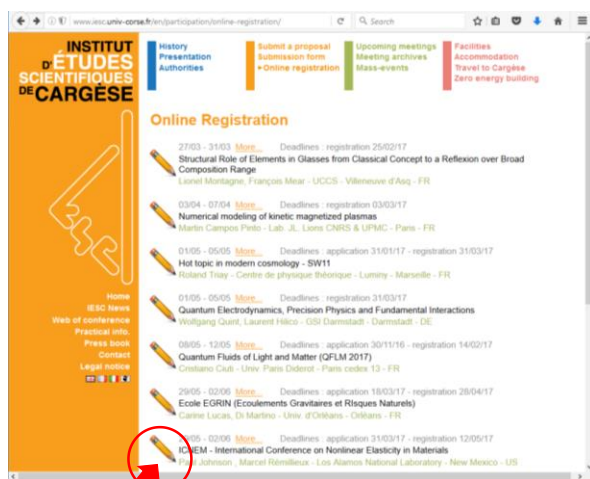
The individual registration for ICNEM (Cargèse, May 28<sup>th</sup> – June 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2017) is a two-step procedure involving:

1. The application process.
2. The registration process.

**Phase 1:** the applicants are required to fill out an application form that is submitted to the scientific committee. The application can be found at the following link:

You will need to create an account.

Applicants will be selected based on their research interest, their academic level (PhD students, Post-docs, Professors, etc.), and eventually, their publication record. An appropriate balance will be found between the different research fields covered by ICNEM: Nonlinear Evaluation of Damage, Characterization of Nonlinear Material Properties, Modeling and Simulation of Nonlinear Elasticity, Nonlinear Elasticity in Granular Materials, Earthquakes and Geophysics.



**Phase 2:** After confirmation of their selection, all applicants have to complete the registration process. Information such as accompanying person(s), accommodation in Cargèse, personal diet, travel information (from and to the Ajaccio airport) will then be registered. Payment of registration fees will also be required (deadline May 12<sup>th</sup>, 2017).

Registration fees are 890 Euros. Note that registration fees are not paid until your application (Phase 1) has been approved.

### *Registration fees include:*

- a) accommodation in a shared-room at the conference site (IESC) or single-room in Cargèse (depending on availability) from Sunday night (May 28<sup>th</sup>) to Saturday morning (June, 3<sup>rd</sup>),
- b) welcome aperitif-style reception on Monday evening (May 29<sup>th</sup>, 2017),
- c) lunches at the conference site,
- d) coffee breaks,
- e) a diner evening at the restaurant on Thursday (June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017),
- f) bus transportation from Ajaccio airport to Cargèse (round-trip).

Note 1: Rooms are assigned by the onsite IESC staff in the town of Cargèse. **If you elect to find your own accommodation, you will forfeit the portion of the registration fee that goes toward lodging.**

Note 2: Except on Thursday evening (June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017), diners are not covered by the registration fee.

## About EGRIN, the Summer School Running in Parallel to ICNEM

The IESC will also host the EGRIN summer school. This school will bring together applied mathematicians and physicists to work on gravity driven flows. A joint ICNEM/EGRIN session will be held on Monday afternoon (May 29<sup>th</sup>, 2017).
